
Duct Tape Crafts

Wallet

Materials Needed:

- Duct Tape, using different colors of duct tape can add fun accents to your wallet. But you can do the craft with just one color.
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Ruler (or a piece of 8 ½ x 11 paper)
- 1. Start by cutting 8 strips of duct tape, each 9 inches.
- 2. Create 2 large sheets. Put 4 lengths of duct tape together with about a ¼ inch overlap.
- 3. Now put the two sheets together so there is no sticky side showing! This is tricky. You'll need to carefully line it up! Once the two sticky sides touch, it's really hard to get them apart.
- 4. Fold over parts of the duct tape if you missed, or you can trim with scissors.







- 5. Now, with your single duct tape sheet, fold it over to create the wallet. Put a strip of duct tape along the short edges to hold the pieces together into the wallet shape.
- 6. Here you have your wallet! You can stop now, or add a pocket for cards.
- 7. Cut 2, 4 inch pieces of duct tape. This will create your card slots.
- 8. Put these two pieces together, sticky sides in. Again, be careful, once they are stuck, it's hard to take them apart. You can trim the edges with scissors.
- 9. I put my card slot on the right side, but you can put it wherever! Put duct tape along the edges of the card slot to adhere it to the wallet.







Feel free to add more pockets, a spot for coins... be creative!

Flower Pen

Materials Needed:

- Duct Tape, using different colors of duct tape can add fun accents to your wallet. But you can do the craft with just one color.
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Rule (or a piece of 8 ½ x 11 paper)
- 1. Cut 2 inch pieces of duct tape. Since I didn't have a ruler, I used a piece of paper to measure. I cut the duct tape the length of the short end of the paper, 8 ½ inches. Then I cut that in half to have 2 pieces around 4 inches. Then finally, cut those in half. To create 2 inch duct tape pieces.
- 2. Now take one of the 2 inch duct tape pieces and fold the top down. It creates a "house shape" make sure to leave the bottom part sticky, this is what while adhere to the stem of the flower (your pen).

3. Now, wrap the sticky part around the top of the pen, making sure the pointy part goes above the top of the pen.









- 4. Now keep making 2 inch duct tape strips and the house shapes!
- 5. Keep wrapping them around the top. This will now start to look like a flower

Tip: Make a bunch of house shapes at one time. Then wrap a bunch of them. This felt more efficient than cutting, folding, and wrapping around the pen one piece at a time

6. Keep going for as much as you want! When you are done, you can fold the outer petals down or leave them up
